



Student Bursary Criteria

Updated February 2020

Eligibility:

- Must be a son/daughter of a member of the Lunenburg County Local, NSTU.
- Parents of the applicant must have amassed 3 full years of teaching service in Lunenburg County to be eligible.
- Applicant must provide a **receipt of proof of registration** in a post-secondary program.
- May apply up to and including 25 years of age.
- May apply on a one-time basis.

Deadline: Application forms must be submitted by April 30th.

Cheque: A cheque (\$300) will be issued to the student upon receipt of proof of registration. A photocopy/scan of the receipt of payment of tuition is acceptable.
